Scripture Reading: 2 Corinthians 6:1, 2

For What Do We Search? by Duane Patton

According to three separate online sources, over 3.5 Billion internet searches are conducted every single day (that's over a trillion per day world-wide)! Google is the reigning champ of on-line search engine traffic processing on average over 40,000 queries per second! I suppose that number excludes the search I performed in looking up these statistics at bing.com, right? That is a truly remarkable number of information searches going on around the globe. One might even argue that it is a never-ending search. A question comes to my mind in consideration of the above research: Do we search for the kingdom of God to the same degree of urgency and frequency? If not, is it because doing so is more difficult? Or, could it be that we find it less interesting or comparably not as important? In any case, consider the following.

While on the earth in human form, Jesus taught that His disciples were to "seek" the kingdom of God and to do so with all urgency and priority (Matthew 6:33; Luke 9:23., 24). The mundane, earthly things of this life are temporary, but God's kingdom is eternal; so, its entry must be weighed against the horrors of eternal condemnation that follow this life for the one who is not in Christ (Romans 2:5-16; 6:23; cf., 2 Thessalonians 1:6-9). Nothing in the world is to be compared to the value of even one soul for whom Christ died; the material world will certainly pass away (Mark 8:36, 37; John 3:16, 17; Luke 15:15; 2 Peter 3:10, 11; 1 John 2:15-17; viz., Mark 13:31). For this reason alone – that our souls stand in constant need of the eternal benefit of Jesus' death – searching for God's kingdom (whether through careful online research or otherwise) should be our worldwide priority! After all, sin is a world-wide problem! The apostle Paul echoed the haunting words of the Psalmist as he documented mankind's problem without God's grace, "There is none righteous, no, not one" (Romans 3:10; cf. Psalms 14:1-3; 53:1-3). The number of searches performed every day are not nearly as important as the thing for which we are all searching. Let's be sure to search for God's kingdom foremost!
