Scripture Reading: Luke 8:9-11

A Real Treasure by Duane Patton

What thoughts comes to your mind when thinking of the word "treasure?" For me, I sometimes think of a deserted island and a Pirate's map with an "X" marking the spot where a hinged chest filled with precious metals and gemstones is buried deep underground. Maybe something else comes to your mind, but certainly your thoughts gravitate toward something of great value and personal worth. Jesus compared the Kingdom of Heaven to hidden treasure when He taught, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field" (Matthew 13:44, NKJV). Whatever the man found in the field was worth far more than the field itself, and the cost of the field would guarantee his access to it!

Biblically, the Kingdom of Heaven is spoken of in two senses, each one being worth more than any earthly treasure. On the one hand, the Kingdom of Heaven is the rule and reign of Jesus Christ in the hearts and lives of men and women everywhere (Matt. 16:18f; Lk. 13:28f; Col. 1:13; Rev. 1:9). Still, the Kingdom of Heaven is that place of eternal joy and rest which the Savior promised to all those whose faith is in Christ when He returns (1 Cor. 15:22-24; cf., Eph. 1:21; Col. 1:5; Matt.19:21). All material things will eventually pass out of existence (2 Peter 3:10-12; viz., Luke 21:33). As much as it may disappoint us to think about a permanent loss of things we value in this life only, we need not be overly saddened. Our Lord, whose own body had been destroyed, arose from the grave with a new body giving us hope beyond the grave (Acts 24:15; Phil. 3:10f). So, instead of spending too much time digging for earthly wealth only to lose it in the end, hunt for real treasure. Let's put even more interest in things that will never pass away (1 Pet. 1:3-5; 2 Pet. 1:10, 11).

"Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matthew 6:19-21, NK, JV)


