Scripture Reading: James 3:2-5

The Last shall be First by Duane Patton

Tesus taught the following to the early disciples regarding service in His kingdom:

"...everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life. But many who are first will be last, and the last first." (Matthew 19:29, 30, NKJV)

Sometimes this teaching has given rise to the idea of an "upside down kingdom." Who in the world would think that being first means being last, or that being last means that one is actually first? It is true that this makes little sense compared to worldly affairs. The runner who crosses the finish line first is the winner, there's no prize for last place. Once famous, now deceased, NASCAR champion Dale Earnhardt, is known for having said, "Second place is first loser." One writer remarked how some take the notion of being first in everything too far, saying "When somebody starts acting like second place is for losers, it doesn't matter if you've won a footrace with everyone on the planet and bested 6,999,999,998 people. All that matters is you didn't beat the one" (source: https://tvtropes.org).

Of course, the problem with this attitude is that it fails to take into consideration that, regardless of how on top of our "game" in this life we may be, it's the one to come that we need to be successful in attaining. The bad news? "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). But, here is the very good news: "[T]hanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ!" (1 Corinthians 15:57). Jesus died so that we might have life; He defeated the enemy that we could not, and He is even kind to the unthankful (2 Corinthians 8:9; Matthew 20:28; Luke 6:35).
