Scripture Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:16, 17

As Christ Loved the Church by Duane Patton

Recently I enjoyed the blessing of attending a beautiful wedding ceremony. Conducted in the auditorium where the church in Vancleave regularly assembles, the marriage of two young Christians filled the room with words and deeds that honored the Lord as the two hearts were woven together by their love for God and for one another. The very act of marriage, when done according to God's will, correlates with the love which Christ has for those whom He has called out to be His spiritual bride.

According to the apostle, Paul, marriage between a man and a woman is to be a reflection of the relationship between Christ and the church. Note the following passage of Scripture:

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish (Ephesians 5:25-27, NKJV)

Imagine a world where men and women love each other to the degree that Christ loved the church and you will see a world filled with New Testament Christianity! A self-sacrificial kind of love would all but eliminate divorce and it would surely go a long, long way regarding handling most issues regarding finances, children and many other difficulties often associated with married life. The Lord did not give just a part of Himself in order to secure a relationship with mankind - not just a convenient portion of His heart – but He gave His entire life so that there might be a new, pure and, in His eternal estimate, perfect union. His deliberate actions of love spoke louder than any words when He died on the cross and subsequently arose from the grave sealing forever His love for all (John 3:16; Ephesians 2:4, 5 cf., Hebrews 13:20, 21). Let us all strive to love as Christ loved the church.
