Something that Lasts Forever by Duane Patton

Nothing lasts forever, right? Outside of the love mentioned by the apostle, Paul, in 1 Corinthians 13:8 which, he says, "never fails," our universe, the world and all that is in it is gradually wearing out. This is because all things material that have a beginning must, by nature, have an ending. Natural science as we understand it refers to this process of gradual decay as the 2nd law of thermodynamics. This is a big word / phrase but only means all material things tend to weaken and eventually fall apart. We can see this all around us. Roads, bridges and buildings, over time, fall into disrepair especially when left completely alone. Even hardened metals when used constantly, given enough use and lack of care, become less effective: they bend, break or rust away. Clothing deteriorates, food spoils. Our human bodies, being mortal, constantly illustrate that we ourselves slow down over time and, eventually, fall apart. The writer of the New Testament book of Hebrews alludes to this by writing, "...it is appointed unto men once to die..." (Hebrews 9:27). Moses recorded man's Maker as having spoken this to the earliest of men "In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return" (cf. Genesis 3:19; cf., Ecclesiastes 3:20). These are but a few of many things that simply do not last forever.

But, there is much good news! Through the Gospel of Jesus and the message of the New Testament provided by Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, God has provided something that lasts forever. According to the Hebrews writer, those who have responded to God's kindness by faith in Jesus Christ are "receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved" (Hebrews 12:28). It is unshakeable (lit., something *impossible* to move) because its builder and maker is God (11:10), and its foundation is the "bedrock" truth that Jesus the man is also the one true and living God (John 1:1-3, 14; see also Hebrews Chapter 1). The "cornerstone" of this unshakeable kingdom is the eternal standard of righteousness by which all the living line up and to which all life is measured (Ephesians 2:19-22). With reference to these things, Jesus, while attending Lazarus' funeral said to Martha, "Your brother will rise again...whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die" (John 11:23, 26). The kingdom of Heaven, in which every faithful child is a citizen, is an eternal kingdom – it is the one thing that lasts forever! Be sure to get in it today!
