Scripture Reading: 2 Peter 3:11-13

The Sin of Ingratitude by Duane Patton

We cannot otherwise do for ourselves – something that we truly need – the most natural and easiest expression of gratitude is to say "thank you." In fact, a general lack of thankfulness is one of the several sins listed among the Gentiles which Paul wrote about in his letter to Christians at Rome.

"...For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened" (Romans 1:18-21, NKJV, emphasis mine, DP).

We may not give much thought to whether anyone says "thank you" to us for a kind deed done to them; or, it might bother us some. Yet, "the wrath of God is revealed from heaven" against those whose dark hearts are characterized by ingratitude. We ought to be thankful in both word and deed for God's marvelous creation, His infinite power (especially with respect to the soul-saving power of the Gospel of Christ), and for the written word of God that reveals His eternal plan for our lives both here on earth and in the world to come!

On this Thanksgiving occasion this year, let's be ever mindful of all the good with which God has so freely enriched our lives. Let us remember one another and the privileges we have as God's children to pray for one another, encourage one another, and promote the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace! Indeed, God has done something for us that we could have never done ourselves.
