Scripture Reading: 2 Thessalonians 1:3

I Don't Know by Duane Patton

Trecall the teaching of the late Thomas B. Warren who, during an illustration of evidence for the existence of God and the acceptance of the Gospel of Christ, asked a member of the audience to step forward and place a mark on the board beside a statement that best described his own belief. On the board were three statements regarding knowledge, and beside each entry was a box in which the guest would mark his/her choice. The first statement was "I know everything," the second was "I know nothing," and the third selection read, "I know something." Surely, you can correctly guess which statement was selected. If you guessed the third one, you are absolutely right, and so was the audience member. In fact, all who were in that meeting could have and would have been bound by conscience to have marked the exact same statement. Why?

The answer is at first obvious. No one on earth has ever had or will ever have the natural ability to know everything – this is a fact far too evidential to argue, regardless of the intellectual prowess of some. An entry on the second selection would simply be self – contradictory as one could not possibly respond in any way at all if he / she knew nothing. This leaves only the third statement as a possibility. But, it is the third selection that forces every accountable person to wrestle not merely with knowledge of a general nature about things mundane and temporal. Indeed, it is the case that the ability to know at least something leads our hearts to learn and to know the truth about God, mankind, sin, death and eternal life made possible by the loving purpose of God and Jesus' commitment to the cross! If we can know one thing, maybe we can know far more.

While it is altogether true that I don't know everything, and I most certainly cannot say that I know nothing, God has given me the ability to know at least *something*. God wants us to know that He loves us and that by faith in His Son, we can also come to know His love for us and so that we can share in the glory of eternal life!

"And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."


