**Exodus:** Abraham's descendants (often referred to in Scripture simply as "Israel") are released from slavery, exit Egypt, cross the Red Sea, receive God's laws for them from Moses at Mount Sinai along with instructions on how to erect the Tabernacle. The Tabernacle would be a portable structure designed to allow Israel to worship and serve God prior to and after entering the land Canaan, the land God promised Abraham to give to his descendants.

#### **Exodus 14:13**

"And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever."
