United in Matters of Faith? Part 3 By Duane Patton

As incredible as it may sound, some individuals of accountable age and mental responsibility have never once heard a word from the Bible. This is only one of several reasons for why so much confusion exists in matters of faith. Hopefully, we will discover about six reasons in our articles on this topic. Consider again a couple other reasons for the confusion and division regarding the Bible and matters of faith.

Some have heard a twisted account of God's word. Confusion sometimes occurs when an individual has been misguided, religiously speaking. Upon hearing the Bible and its message for the first time, a person may not know who, what or even how to believe. Peter, an early writer and apostle of Jesus Christ, warned the churches about some unstable teachers who "twist the Scriptures to their own destruction" (2 Peter 3:16). Likewise, today many sincere folks have heard similar perversions of truth revealed in God's word. So-called differences of "interpretation" sometimes fall into this category of mishandling the word of truth partly because former generations who were themselves misinformed. These might include close friends, relatives, preachers, teachers, etc. Yet, we are all are under equal obligation to "handle aright" the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15).

Some have been conditioned against God's word. Should one have the grave disadvantage of growing up in a culture or society hostile to the Bible, this person stands little chance of understanding the message within the sacred page. Prejudice, or bias, regarding the biblical text create an anti-Bible mentality as though the book itself is somehow harmful to one's way of life. In other instances, some may consider the Bible simply as a collection of writings by mere humans no more valuable than the writings of Shakespeare, Poe, or Homer — maybe writings that are good for some people, but certainly not for everyone. These are similar to biblical characters like Festus who said of the apostle Paul, "Too much learning is driving you insane!" (Acts 26:24). Those who are conditioned against God's word see the Bible as a real imposition to their lives. This only leads to further confusion and division. But we are to "let the word...dwell in us richly" (Colossians 3:16).

A weekly synopsis of every book of the Bible with a memory verse designed to increase our faith Ruth: A truly amazing story of righteousness, love and faithfulness to the Lord and to family, Ruth relates the life of a young non-Israelite girl who married into the Hebrew family. Ruth's husband, along with his brother and their father died leaving only Ruth's sister-in-law and their mother-in-law to fend for their lives under very harsh circumstances. They dwelt alone during the extremely difficult period as referenced in Judges. Yet, godly conduct, right attitudes and wise choices on Ruth's part led her to marry a near-kinsman of her then deceased husband. The marriage of Ruth to Boaz was an unlikely but fortunate union. Ruth became a vital part of the ancestry of King David and, eventually of the world's savior, Jesus of Nazareth (Romans 1:3)
