United in Matters of Faith? Part 4 By Duane Patton

Whereas some individuals of accountable age and mental responsibility have never once heard a word from the Bible, still others have heard only a twisted account of God's word. And some have even been conditioned against God's word. These are but a few reasons that help explain why so much confusion exists about the matter of faith – especially the unity of faith for which Jesus prayed when He bowed low before His heavenly Father. While praying for those disciples who would soon be His official, devoted spokesmen, our Savior said,

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (**John 17:20, 21**)

Despite our Lord's earnest prayer for unity, **some have turned away from God's word**. In vain, many teach and even more believe the error that once God pardons a soul from the guilt incurred by sin, that soul cannot afterward so sin as to be eternally lost. This error is embraced by many chiefly because of a failure to correctly understand the Scriptures on the meaning of eternal life. Yet, the Bible is clear on this. Peter once wrote, "You therefore, beloved, be on your guard so that you are not carried away by the error of unprincipled men and fall from your own steadfastness" (**2 Peter 3:17**; cf., **2:20**, **21; Hebrews 4:11**, ESV). Sadly, some in the first century were in danger of having "believed in vain" while others were in danger of falling from a state of grace (**1 Corinthians 15:1**, **2; Galatians 5:4**). Paul prophesied that some previous faithful ones would turn away from the truth of God's word (**2 Timothy 4:1-5; Acts 20:28-30**). Jesus emphatically taught this in the parable of the soils: some would receive, believe and, in time, leave (**Matthew 13:2**; cf., **John 15:8**). Although these passages and others like them have been sorely abused and twisted by prominent influencers of homiletical prowess, New Testament writers have plainly documented the real possibility and deadly consequences of a precious soul turning away from God's word although that soul was saved and, for a time, kept by the power of God through faith (**1 Peter 1:3-5**). This, too, has led to much confusion over the Bible and matters of faith. "Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him." (Hebrews 10:38, KJV)

1 Samuel: Samuel was a prophet and the last of the Judges who rescued Israel during some of the nation's darkest days, morally speaking. This book details Samuel's work as a Judge in Israel. It also provides great insight on the nation's desire for an earthly king and the forty-year reign and tragic death of Saul. Saul was the king Israel wanted when they rejected God as their King, (viz., 8:6). The book also records the anointing of David as Saul's successor. In 1 Samuel, the kingdom of Israel is solidified.
