## The Problem of Sin by Duane Patton

God's wrath is a consequence of His utter hatred of sin. He stands eternally opposed to sin. Because of God's love for mankind, He has given everyone the freedom to choose between loving God and not loving God. This is a real choice based on man's real desire, and not some deterministic effect based only on what God wants for mankind. Man commits sin when he himself – unabetted by God – chooses to not love God as he should. God is grieved when this occurs. Here are merely a few reasons why God is so grieved.

1. Sin puts distance between God and His creation – man cannot approach God on His own terms. King David understood that any attempt to escape the knowledge of God is futile (**Psalms 139**). Yet, sin places mankind "at odds" with God and with man's own fellow man. Again, sin creates an unnecessary breach between the Creator and the created - a distance too far for man alone to reconcile his relationship to God (**Isaiah 59:1, 2; Ezekiel 33:11;** cf., **1 Corinthians 6:14-7:1**).

2. Sin is similar to a disease that destroys man's soul – man cannot heal his spiritual infirmity in his own way. The life God gives man at conception is eternal – it is without end. But, over time man transgresses God's will (when he commits sin, knowingly or not) and thereby he invites progressive, spiritual destruction on himself which requires a perpetual, spiritual remedy (**Romans 3:23; 6:23**).

3. Sin requires a payment to be made – man cannot afford the high cost of sin with his own means. Once trust is broken between man and his Maker, restitution must be made, or permanent loss will occur. But, the price for redeeming the soul of even one man is simply too high a price for any mere human to pay. Forfeiture of God's help renders all incapable of paying the sin debt (John 5:37-39; Matthew 23:37; cf. Hosea 7:13).

There is a solution to the sin problem. The solution is in God demonstrating His love toward us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (**Romans 5:6-11**). Through tender mercies of God and the eternal riches of His unique Son Jesus Christ, the problem of sin can be fully resolved (**Romans 3:24ff; 2 Corinthians 8:9**)!

## **Rightly Dividing the Word**

A weekly synopsis of every book of the Bible with a memory verse designed to increase our faith

**Job:** Written as Hebrew poetry, Job is an amazing account of one man's intense suffering for reasons neither he nor his companions can adequately explain. The reader has the advantage of knowing that the suffering is caused by a spiritual adversary who is attacking the goodness of God. Job learns that it is not absence of trouble in life that measures God's love and care for him, and that faithfulness to God ultimately results in God's blessings. Despite the harsh realities of life – many of which have no obvious, immediate explanation, we, in some ways like Job, are to be every vigilant in our loyalty to God who is our maker and redeemer, and true friend.

This week's memory verse:

"For I know hat my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand at last on the earth. And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh I shall see God." (Job 19:25, 26, NK, JV)
