The following is for the consideration of local / regular attendees of the church of Christ in Vancleave.

For above ten years I have willingly assumed responsibility for publishing the weekly church bulletin. Previously, Brother Earl Kenney, while serving as one of our elders, worked tirelessly and for a good while to publish a similar, local church bulletin. He certainly ought to be remembered and recognized for the good service he then provided! By your constant input and ongoing support from that time until now the Weekly Newsletter (now, Prayer Requests and Announcements) has been, in my opinion, a general help overall. It continues to be a source of spiritual strength for many, even for some who do not regularly assemble with us.

However, I have come to believe that I should let go of this assumed responsibility for at least two good reasons. **First**, my not carrying the weight of Newsletter publication will afford me more time and energy to sharpen my own local ministry both in and out of the pulpit while also creating more flexibility to serve more adequately as one of your elders, both of which are very demanding in the areas of much time and effort.

Second, divesting myself of the Newsletter will naturally afford others / another the opportunity to exercise faith. The visual presentation / style, content, frequency, timeliness, accuracy and overall production will depend on whoever would volunteer to take this ministry opportunity, pending eldership approval, of course. I would think the eldership would also desire a general editor - someone who is sound in the faith to ensure that, among other things, doctrinal integrity for all articles is maintained and that overall spiritual balance of Newsletter content throughout is preserved.

While publishing such a Newsletter is no small task, its benefits are profoundly rewarding. I simply have let go of the reins for my own ministry's sake and to enable / encourage others in the freedom to exercise their faith in this valuable service. *I intend to personally cease publication not later than the last Sunday of this year (2023)*.
